The Ballroom Dance Company originates in the Department of Dance of the College of Health and Human Performance at Brigham Young University in Provo, Utah.

The team will also participate in dance clinics and youth outreach projects in the cities they visit. During their Logan residency workshop participants will be treated to a wide variety of dance steps and dance numbers.
