During the walk, many of the locations will be collecting food for the Cache Community Food Pantry– you can help the community get *Hungry for the Arts!* by bringing a non-perishable food item with you to any location on the walk on December 2, the Winter Gift Market on December 2 & 3, during the Parade of Gingerbread Homes throughout the month of December, or at any other arts event in our community. The Cache Valley Arts Summit needs your help this holiday season because no one should go hungry in our beautiful Cache Valley.
