

High School Art Show Rules and Requirements

General Requirements and Rules

- A. There is no specific theme so feel free to create whatever type of art you would like but just be sure you do your best work because there will be prizes awarded.
 - a. The show opens with a Gallery Walk (6-9pm) on April 16th and runs through May 14th.
- B. All artwork must be clearly labeled with the following information. If it is a 3D item and that information won't fit then the name must be clearly written on it at the very least.
 - a. Name (First and Last)
 - b. Title of the piece
 - c. School
 - d. Age
- C. Please use the attached submission form and labeling form to prepare your pieces before you bring it in to the AVA. Please write legibly just in case we need to contact the artist for any reason.
- D. Submissions will be accepted on Tuesday April 13th and Wednesday April 14th from 1:00 – 6:00 pm.
 - a. NO ENTRIES WILL BE TAKEN AFTER 6:00pm WEDNESDAY
- E. The artist does not have to sell their works but if they choose to, they will receive 70% of the selling price. The AVA keeps 30% to cover Administrative costs of selling the piece.
 - a. The artist will receive a check for their part of the sale within 30 days of the end of the show.

Art Work Requirements and Rules

- 1. 2 Dimensional Art (paintings, drawings, photos, collages, poems, etc...)
 - a. All entries must be SECURELY framed (you don't need to have it professionally framed, just secure so it won't fall apart when hung or picked up)
 - b. All entries must have a WIRE securely fastened to the frame and strung across the back of the work (side to side) so that it can be hung from an S hook and chain system.
 - i. The wire and backing must be securely fastened to the frame
 - ii. Taped yarn or string is NOT acceptable to use as a hanging system
 - iii. The frame does not have to have glass in it. This will be helpful if the artwork is dimensional or sticks out a bit.
- 2. 3 Dimensional Art (ceramics, weaving, crochet, sculpture, etc...)
 - a. All entries must be clearly labeled with at least the student's name
 - b. Make sure that all pieces are securely fastened so that the artwork does not fall apart or break while being moved into place.
